	 Will we be doing road maintenance this year? We are looking to have an asset management plan put together that will detail the condition of our roads and determine what needs to be repaired and what the expected lifespan remaining is. Street sweeping concerns – (there was a breakdown in the equipment that caused a delay part way through) Pest control – is there anything for gophers? Poulins sells a cost-effective product that is available. Residents are responsible for private property, Hamlet Board will look into public spaces. Is there a bylaw for bb guns and pellet guns? 


